Valor Games Southeast Wheelchair Basketball and Golf Tournaments for Veterans with Disabilities: August 21 and 23

Bridge II Sports' 'Summer of Valor Games Southeast' continues with the final two events: a wheelchair basketball tournament on August 21 and golf tournament August 23.

Due to continued vigilance of Covid-19, this year's games were shifted to 4 one-day events throughout the summer instead of the usual one three-day event to allow involvement with smaller groups. Veteran athletes with physical disabilities from around the country attended the first two events at Lake Crabtree County Park in May and at Bridge II Sports in June.

These life changing events are made possible through a grant from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs and support from several community and corporate partners.
